We are pleased to know that many of this year's students have already committed to return to Mohyla next fall. Soon the summer program will come into effect at Mohyla to welcome and accommodate Canadian students registered for a group study program offered by the University of Saskatchewan. As well, a summer plan is in place to refresh specific areas in the building in time for the commencement of the new academic year this fall. Our cheery, dedicated leader, Executive Director, Sara Detenshen and her staff indeed demonstrate what it takes to make a not-for-profit institution such as Mohyla a place where students are welcomed, valued and inspired in their pursuit of academic studies and their personal and community development. We thank Sara and her staff for the laudable work they do.

While Mohyla has had its share of "ups and downs" over the years, its spirit, resilience and focus on serving people thankfully continues to strive and grow incrementally in an increasingly competitive and diverse economic and social environment. For example, our bottom line financial outcome for the past year is probably the best in comparison to at least the past two decades.

It was a bumpy and distressing process, working through the many necessary health and operational constraints of COVID-19 such as staff and budget cutbacks, and uncertainties and limitations on accommodations for student residents; however, with dedicated discipline and firm resolve it did get done. Now it's time to get our eyes back on the road ahead.

We plan to get our work back on the road in developing and refining the Mohyla Conceptual Plan into a business plan, while also doing what is necessary to ensure that the current 59 year old dated facility is kept safe, sound and functional for our valued student residents. Essentially, the next phase of the process is to transition the Mohyla Conceptual Plan to a fully detailed business plan which will provide the full scope of design, costs, and pertinent facts that when completed, will be presented to Mohyla members for a vote of approval to proceed. Building a new Mohyla state-of-the-art facility will depend on you, and all members of the Ukrainian community coming together to make it a reality.
